The workshop was divided into two sessions, the first in the morning and the second in the afternoon. In the morning session a lecture demonstration was conducted by Mr Pankaj Munjal. Mr. Pankaj Munjal talked about issues related to gender inequality in our society. A Powerpoint presentation on the topic Gender Sensitivity was shown along with a few videos. The manner in which complaints are to be addressed was also explained. He provided a number of suggestions to promote gender sensitivity in the school environment in order to educate and inculcate

gender sensitivity right from childhood. The participants participated actively in the open house discussion and were appreciative about getting an opportunity to know and discuss gender sensitivity at school. Around 50 participants from various schools attended this workshop. They were given a certificate of participation. It is hoped that schools also conduct such workshops in future.

The workshop was attended by about 50 teachers of various subjects. It was divided into two sessions, the first in the morning and the second in the afternoon. In the morning session, Dr. Kumar started the workshop with a very interesting and exciting activity, the paper aeroplanes and told to write one word which makes you feel happy. With this activity, teachers can know the emotional intelligence of a child, also by engaging all students they learn to be more interactive with each other. She beautifully explained the journey of self-awareness to self-acceptance. Then the workshop moved with one activity of logo making on happiness. She put emphasis on why we do not feel happy and how not to carry baggage of unhappiness... try to recycle by forgetting or forgiving. In the post-lunch session, she narrated a cobbler story and told to distinguish between personal and professional front and balance them. The most important part of the work was to make students learn impulse control by breaking conventional thinking. A teacher should say I teach Science instead of I teach children. Never punish the child but get a confession note from him/her. Keep your narrative positive. In the workshop, all teachers played with Simon says.... It was really effective in impulse control. The last but not the least, creating a treasure trunk of gratitude like, I am grateful for.... How can I nurture a garden of optimism. It is hoped that schools also conduct such workshops in the future. Takeaways of the workshop: Self-awareness, Self-motivation, Be realistic, Be happy, Teacher's tool kit for emotional intelligence regulation.

Most of the topics like TEACHING LEARNING CYCLE, BLOOMS TAXONOMY in the handout were explained by the teams (as the topics were divided among them), though the resource person added in between to emphasize on certain points . including:

- *Setting shared expectations between students and instructors,
 - *Helping students learn more effectively. *Providing clear direction for educators when making instruction and assessment decisions.
 - *Focus on the student--what the student will be able to do by the end of the course or program.
 - *Describe outcomes, not processes or activities.
 - *Start each outcome with an action verb.
- Overall it was a satisfactory workshop.
