To commemorate the birth anniversary of Dr.Sarvepalli Radhakrishnan, 5th September is celebrated as National Teachers' Day in India.













Out of happiness you cry,



Kindly make a note of the following points in this regard:


- ✓ Ensure that during examination days your ward turns up to the school in proper school uniform.


