




Happiness Curriculum Class III Date- 26.1.2023






Happiness Curriculum Class V Outdoor Activities


'Life is meant for good friends and great adventures.'
























Basant Panchami Class 1 January 25, 2023





Lala Lajpat Rai Jayanti Class V 27-01-23
















International Day of Education

The United Nations General Assembly proclaimed 24th January as the International Day of Education, in celebration of the role of education for peace and development.


To make the students aware of the role of education in their lives, an activity was conducted in Class 1. The students

The students were quite interested to know the story of these brave hearts.









Veer Bal Diwas is celebrated on 26th December

remained steadfast and resolute till the very end.




































WORLD PULSES DAY DATE: 10.02.2023

They brought a variety of lip-smacking cuisines made of pulses and millets and motivated their peers to include these in their diet on a daily basis in order to stay healthy.































National Deworming Day Class II Date -10-02-2023

First aid is a life-saving technique using which we can save lives with minimal equipment. It is a form of emergency care provided to an injured person on an immediate basis.






Art Integrated Maths Activity Class II




Mathematics - Fractions Class III 23.01.23




















EVS TOPIC - LET'S CONTROL POLLUTION CLASS IV

The environment is the shield that protects the Earth. One must try and make it a better place for the coming generations. It is nature's gift that helps in nourishing life on Earth.






















