- The topics are endless. Pick up a topic each day and discuss its main components with your ward. Children will develop interest in this process and shall start asking why's and how's about the topic.










Be the Green Warrior



- Keeping self clean by maintaining personal hygiene.




Prepare a magic plastic box. The box should contain below mentioned items. Kindly send the same along with the Holiday Homework to school by 10.07.2023.






TRACE IT WITH FINGER TIP








TRACE WITH CRAYON















FINE MOTOR SKILL DEVELOPMENT




