




50th NPSE Annual Conference

This has resulted in a joyful and engaging learning experience for the students.






















#### **BAISAKHI CELEBRATION**

#### Jallianwala Bagh Massacre Day

13.04.23 Class V-A and V-B

Jallianwala Bagh Massacre, also called Massacre of Amritsar, occurred on April 13, 1919, in which British troops fired on a large crowd of unarmed Indians in an open space known as the Jallianwala Bagh in Amritsar in the Punjab region (now in Punjab state) of India, killing several hundred people and wounding many hundreds more. The Jallianwala Bagh massacre marked a turning point in India's struggle for Independence. A memorial was set up by the Government of India in 1951 at Jallianwala Bagh to commemorate the spirit of Indian revolutionaries and the people who lost their lives in the brutal massacre. In order to brief the students about this incident, a short documentary was shown in the class. Students were also told after effects of this tragic incident. It was helpful in sensitising the young minds about the kind of struggle and sacrifice the Indians had gone through to gain independence.

#### **Trip to Jim Corbett and Nainital**




