



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






ORIENTATION PROGRAMME Classes I and II July 10,2023

Classroom management is not about having the right rules, it is about having the right relationships.

To make classroom more interactive, CBSE organized a workshop on Capacity Building Programme on Classroom Management at SD Girls Senior Secondary School on 17th and 18th August 2023. The workshop was attended by teachers hailing from various CBSE schools of Delhi. The workshop focused on the key concern of classroom management with the rise of effective teaching strategies. The resource persons Dr. Meenakshi Gupta (Principal of SSD Public School) and Mrs Rajni Kashyap (Principal of DAV Public School, Model Town) discussed and shared the best methods adopted for classroom management and how

the best potential of students could be extracted by giving them congenial and friendly environment.

The workshop addressed questions giving teachers various practical eye opening strategies they can use for managing students' physical and behaviour patterns. They also explained the latest strategies to manage the classroom environment effectively. Through discussion, it was established that with changing times, the challenges faced by teachers in the classroom have also changed and the need to develop and implement rules and procedures to tackle the same is of utmost

importance. The resource person emphasized that the quality of teacher-student relationship is the keystone for all other aspects of classroom management. Various activity sessions were also discussed.

The resource person also discussed the various components of classroom management, consequences and rewards. Overall, the workshop was quite advantageous for teachers and will surely act as a tool to manage our classrooms more effectively in a more disciplined way to provide more enriching and better results.


CPD on Holistic Progress Card (as per NEP 2020) and Metacognition

The theme of the event was PATRIOTISM. Significant messages were spread through their poems. All the spectators thoroughly enjoyed their performances.





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
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English Poem Recitation Competition Class I 16 August, 2023


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REPORT ON VISIT TO NGO 'SAMPOORNA' DATE : 28.07.23





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
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Paper Bag Making Class IV 12.07.23

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


Class I Date- 03.08.23




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Subject Enrichment Activity CLAY MOULDING 11 August, 2023 Class I

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


Best Out Of Waste Photo Frame Making Class II 09.07.23


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
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Meditation And Laughter Yoga Class III 01.08.23



Children dressed up in colourful attires and participated enthusiastically and enjoyed the activity a lot.







### English Relate mutually with similes and metaphors Class IV 15th July, 2023


E.V.S CLASS - IV TOPIC- Gram Panchayat ( Sarpanch Elections)




**Getting hooked to newspapers**






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


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
EVS : Landforms of India Collage Making Class V July 13, 2023



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






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
Bagless Day Class V 14.08.23

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Exploring India's Diversity Class V 7th August, 2023



This project not only fostered a sense of appreciation for the diverse heritage of India, but also encouraged students to develop their research, presentation and public-speaking skills.












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English Week Activities CLASS III Date: 21.08.23 to 25.08.23

The students were given worksheets related to spellings along with some clues. It was indeed a brain storming activity. Day 5: NEWSPAPER ACTIVITY


The students were asked to bring the printout of a newspaper article. They had to scratch their brains and find out six differences between the given pictures.





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


Value Education

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






**English- Grammar (Nouns)**

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
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## Investiture Ceremony Primary Department August 17,2023
