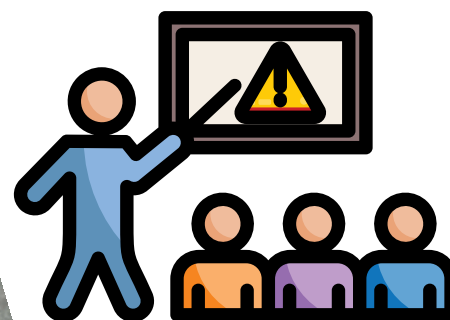




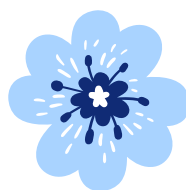




Disaster Management Drill
