The event was a celebration of legacy, innovation, and unity for a sustainable tomorrow.







#### Understanding Student Misbehaviour

Speaker Ms. Jayshree Mehta







The session by Ms. Jayshree Mehta on student misbehaviour emphasized the importance of understanding both verbal and non-verbal cues in classroom management. Key strategies included using proximity praise to encourage positive behaviour and employing the Target-Stop-Do method to redirect misbehaving students. Special attention was given to handling rude behaviour with patience, calm body language, and consistent communication at the same eye level. The importance of avoiding accusatory "why" questions was highlighted. Common causes of misbehaviour discussed included attention-seeking, lack of understanding, ignorance, home environment, and emotional dysregulation. Ms. Mehta stressed that even negative attention is often preferred over no attention, cautioning against indifference. She also recommended devoting two minutes daily for 100 days to include and uplift lowperforming students. The session encouraged teachers to address misbehaviour empathetically, focusing on perspective and proactive engagement.

Ten mathematics teachers from the N.K. Bagrodia chain of schools in Delhi attended the session and found it highly informative.






### Teaching Pedagogies and Learning Outcomes


