**1. The Session 2026–27 will commence as per the following schedule:**

**All Saturdays will be non-working for the students.**

- Students must report to the school in proper school uniform (House uniform every Tuesday and Friday) and carry appropriate books and notebooks as per the Class Timetable. Also, ensure that the school bag is not overloaded.
- Students should carry appropriate sportswear to the school in case of any engagement in sporting activities.
- Indicate a choice concerning the Co-scholastic activities and preference for the bus routes as per the bus route chart available at the school reception.
- It is advisable that your ward(s) should wear a mask in case of cold/cough/any such ailment and maintain hygiene.
- Wearing the Student ID Card is mandatory. Parents/Guardians must carry a Parent/ Guardian ID Card while picking up the child.
- It is earnestly requested not to drop your ward at the school gate before 7:40 a.m. The school gates will be closed at 7:55 a.m. sharp. **No entry will be allowed thereafter.**  
**Parents are requested to maintain decorum and not indulge in arguments with the school staff.**
- Kindly do not drop the tiffin box, stationery item or any other item belonging to your ward(s) during the school hours.
- Kindly ensure that the particulars of your ward, as provided at the time of enrolment, are as per the school official records. Inform the Class Teacher of any changes with valid proof.

10. Students should not be riding a two-wheeler while commuting to and from the school.
11. Parents are requested to send fruits in a separate tiffin box for the Fruit Break apart from the regular lunch.
12. Kindly ensure that either the father's or the mother's phone number is included in the Class WhatsApp Group made for circulating necessary information.
13. Kindly communicate your queries at the school reception or through the school almanac.
14. Parents are requested to ensure that their wards are picked up promptly after school dispersal.
15. Students are not permitted to carry mobile phones within the school premises. In cases where it is indispensable for them to carry a basic mobile phone, the device must be deposited at the school reception. Failing this, the mobile phone is liable to be confiscated for 15 days.
16. Students to reach home within the expected travel time between the school and their home.
17. Students are advised not to move around outside the school premises unnecessarily after the dispersal.
