CLASS IX - 2026-27

As per the instructions of Directorate of education and CBSE, promotion of class IX students will be based on internal assessment, mid-term examination and annual examination.

1. In order to be declared pass, a student must secure **33% marks separately in Theory and Internal Assessment** in each of the five subjects studied by him /her. The student is allowed to opt for the sixth subject as well.

4. A student who is not able to secure 33% marks according to the computed result is eligible to appear in the Compartment examination in **Two subjects**. Only one attempt will be granted to appear in the compartment examination and no grace will be permissible in the same.

- a. In case a student is not able to appear in any periodic examination due to medical reasons, the weightage of that examination will be calculated on the basis of the average of marks obtained by the student in other periodic examination of the respective subject.
- b. In case a student is not able to appear in mid-term examination due to medical reasons, marks for that subject will be calculated as 80% from the annual examination and 20% from internal assessment, subject to the submission of medical certificate from a registered medical practitioner within 24 hours.
- c. However, if the student is not able to appear in the annual examination because of medical reasons, he/she will be allowed to appear in the compartment examination for that subject(s), subject to the submission of medical certificate from a registered medical practitioner within 24 hours.

5. As per CBSE circular no. CBSE/COORD /Shortage -Attend./2025 dtd. 04/08/2025, **a minimum of 75% attendance is mandatory for students to be eligible to appear for the examinations.**

6. The student also needs to adhere to the moral code of conduct and discipline at all times. Further, carrying mobile phones to school is strictly prohibited.
